BETHEL METHODIST CHURCH

Leon County, Fla.

This beautiful white church and its cemetery are in a quiet grove of oak and magnolia a few hundred feet south of Highway 90 about three miles west of Tallahassee, Township 1 N, Range 2 W, Section 25. The present building dates from 1909, but the congregation is much older. Founded in 1834, Bethel is one of the oldest Methodist congregations in Leon County, antedated only by Pisgah and Trinity in Tallahassee. The cemetery shows evidence of some old burials, now unmarked. The original church structure was apparently near the present site. Some of the oldest stones are near the church.
