



Come, Sinners, to the Gospel Feast


**1. Come, sinners,

Jesus' guest.**




**Ye need not one

all humankind.**




**2. Do not begin

his grace refuse;**




**your worldly cares

hath to give.**




**3. Come and partake

in Jesus rest;**




**O taste the goodness

and drink his blood.**




**4. See him set forth
