C.C. Smith and Lilla Burns

C.C. Smith was a lay person from Tritinity who served as pastor at Bethel from 1921-1931; Lilla began the writing of Bethel's History in 1947





Dr. W.F. Dunkle, pastor at Bethel 1944-1947

The writing of Bethel Church history was begun in 1947 by Dr. Dunkle and Lilla Burns for Bethel's "centennial"

"It was during the pastorate of W.F. Dunkle that the church was finished and refurnished. Later the concrete porches and steps were built. Later still a stove was installed and the wiring and light fixtures were put in."

W. Calvin Williams was pastor at Bethel from 1958 until his death in 1963.Wife Lucene served as minister from 1963-1965




Wedding of Jim & Joan Reichart, Dec 20, 1958 (Note "slatted" pews, windows behind pulpit)


Homecoming 1962 Celebrating 115 Birthday of Bethel Methodist Church

Notice: announcement board, dark molding, drape over windows, communion table in front of altar



Lucene Williams became minister in Dec 1963 on the death of Calvin Williams, serving until June 1965




Bethel United Methodist Church - 1968






