


# Christ Is Risen




**1. Christ is risen,

be unafraid!**




**Death and darkness

in which he lay.**




**Do not look

forevermore;**




**tell the world

he goes before.**




**2. If the Lord

because I live.”**




**As we share the

come to reign.**







**3. Death has lost
