


# **There's Within My Heart a Melody**


**1. There's within my

sweet and low;**




**Fear not, I am with thee,

keeps me singing as I go.**




**2. All my life was wrecked

heart with pain;**




**Jesus swept across

all the way.**




## *Refrain*

sheltering wing,**




**always looking on
