## Psalm 76 (NLT)

**A psalm of Asaph. A song to be accompanied by stringed instruments.**

- 1 God is honored in Judah;  
his name is great in Israel.**
- 2 Jerusalem is where he lives;  
Mount Zion is his home.**
- 3 There he has broken the fiery arrows of the  
enemy, the shields and swords and  
weapons of war.**

- 4 You are glorious and more majestic than the everlasting mountains.

O God, and to rescue the oppressed of  
the earth.
- 10 Human defiance only enhances your glory,  
for you use it as a weapon.
- 11 Make vows to the Lord your God,
