

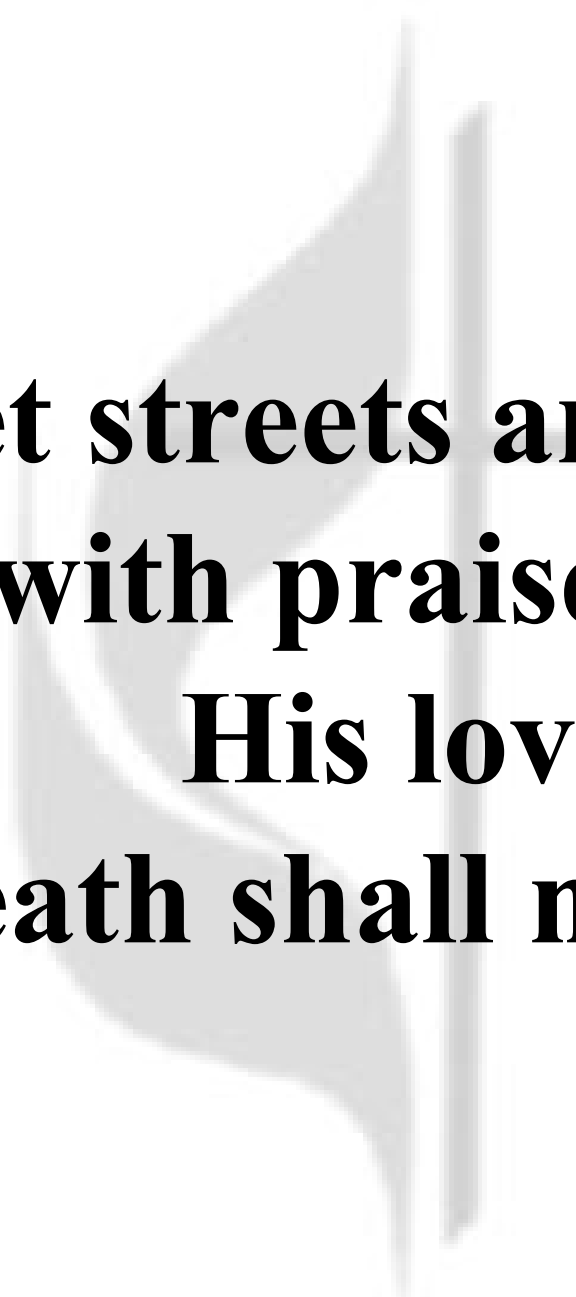

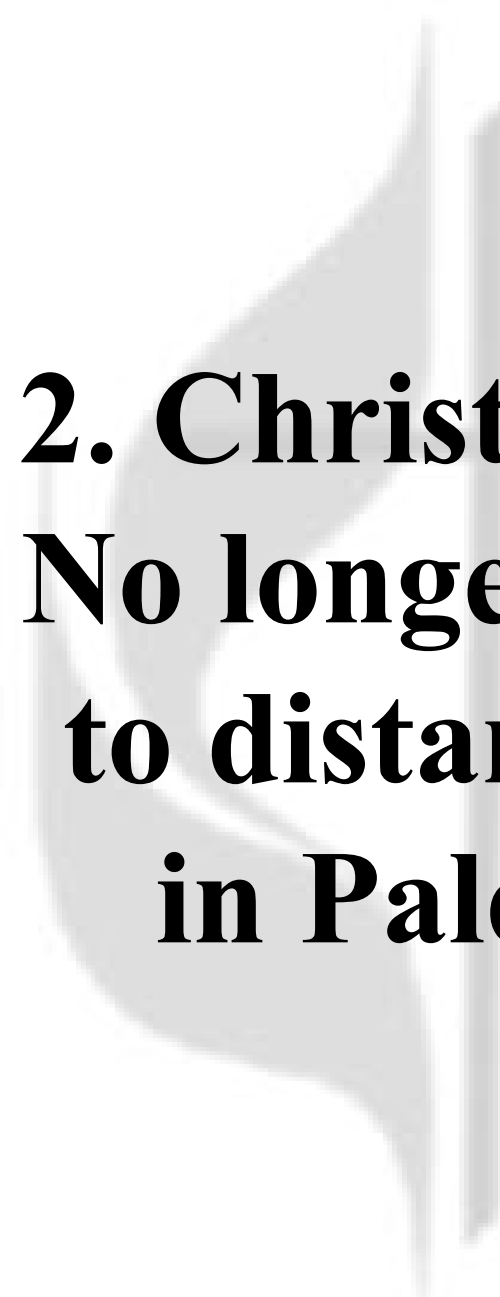

to the sky.**

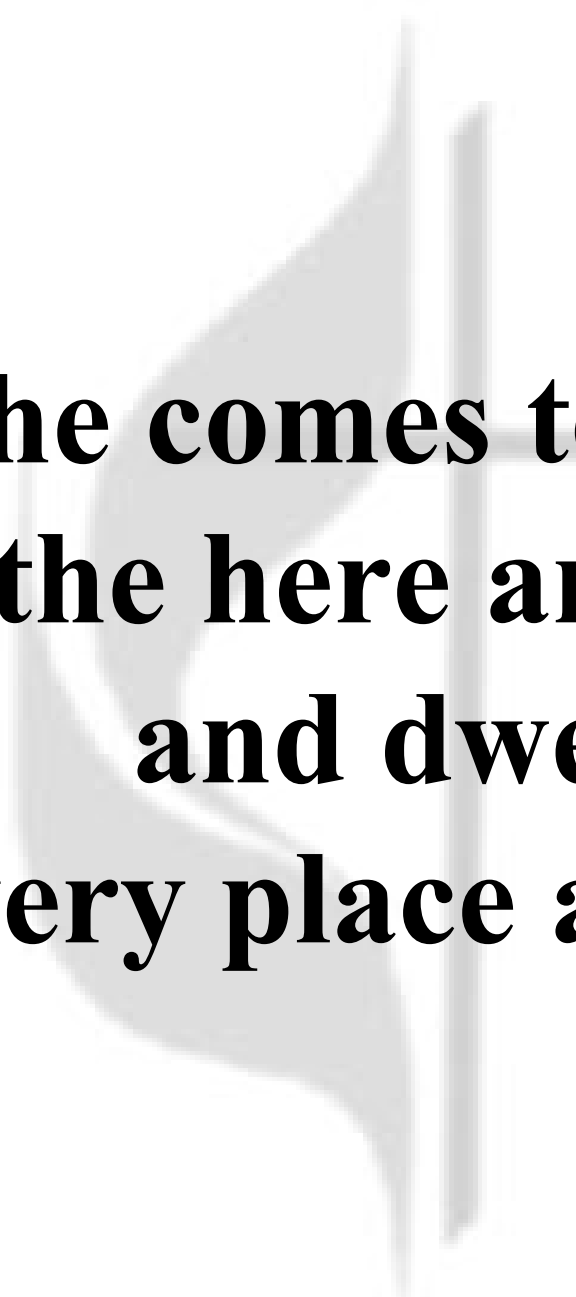

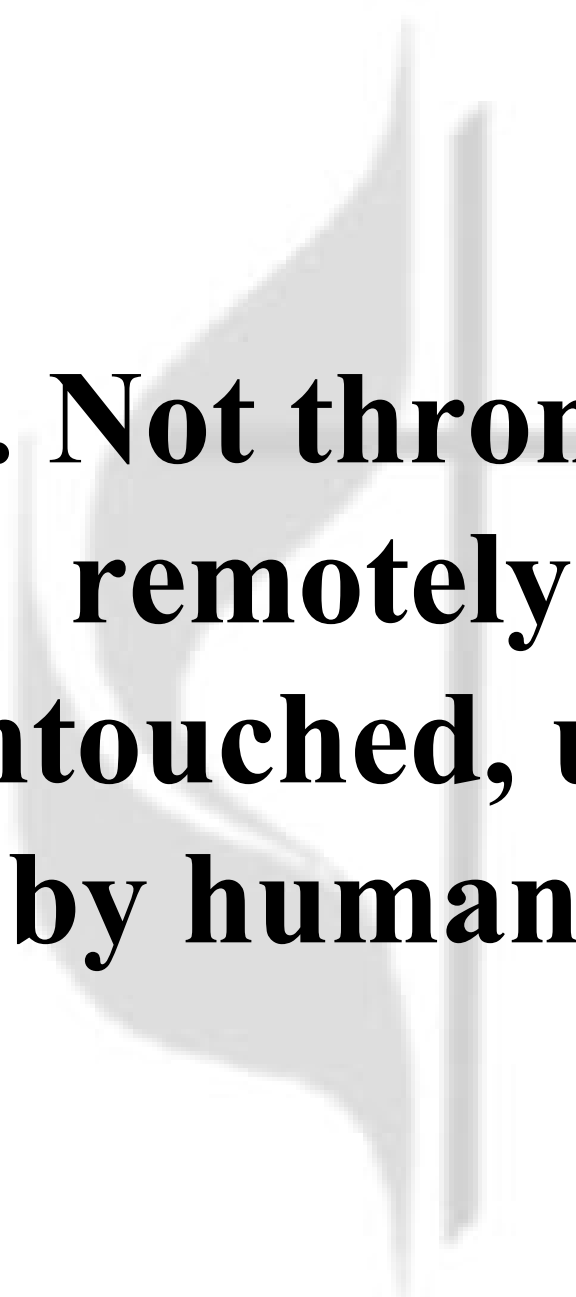
**Let streets and homes

in Palestine,**



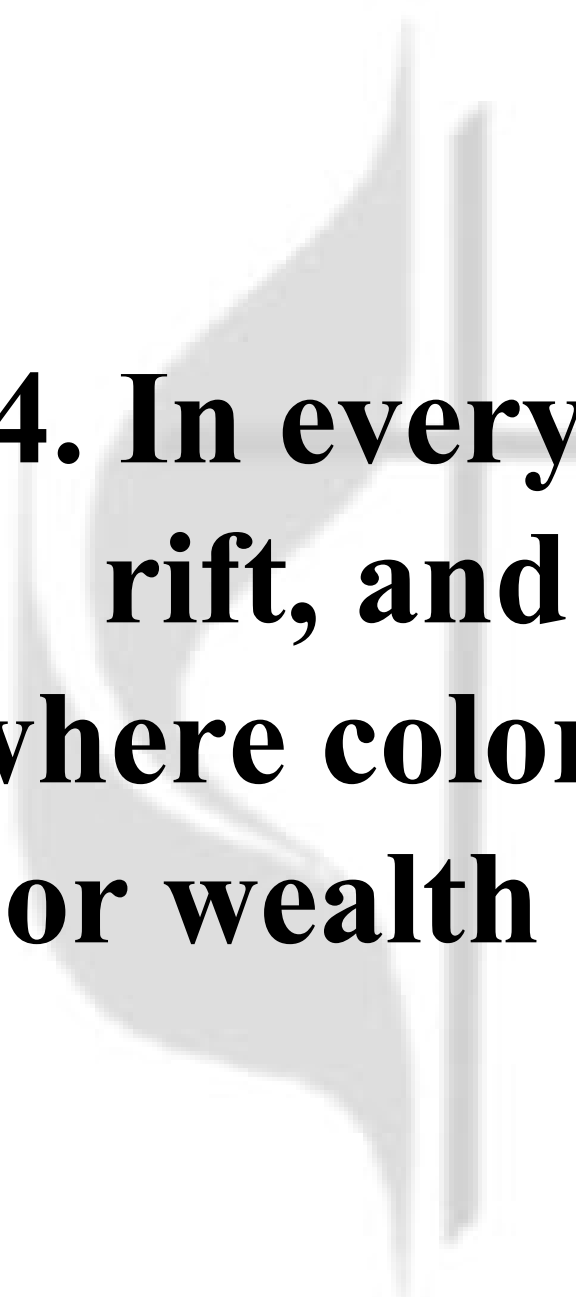
**he comes to claim

every place and time.**



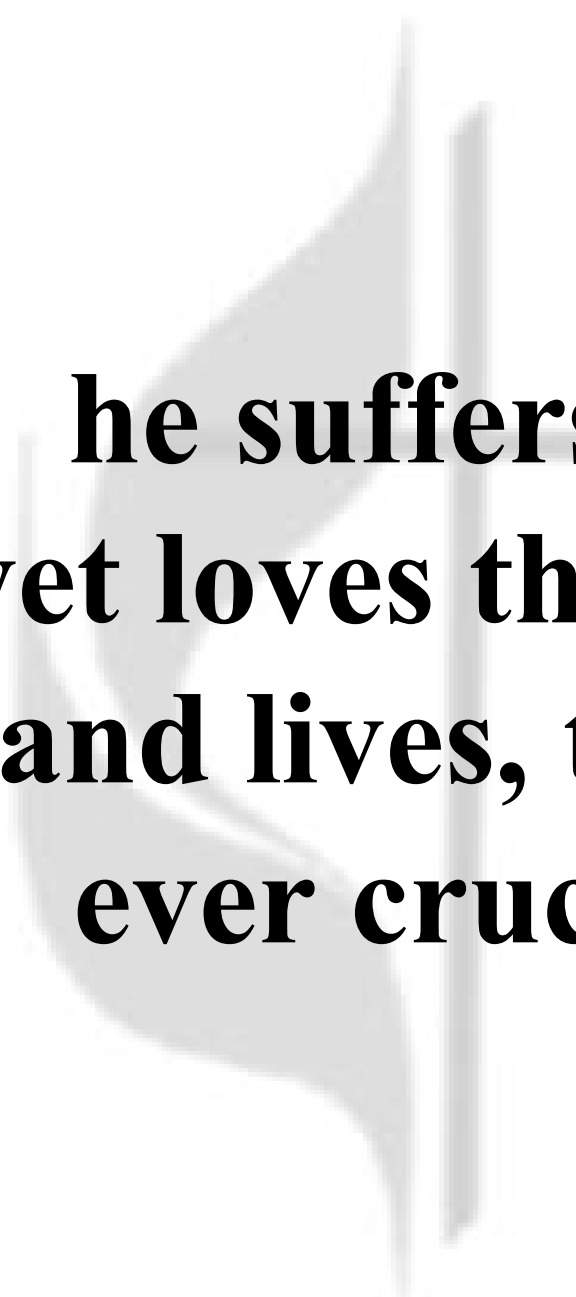
**3. Not throned afar,

the Godhead reigns.**



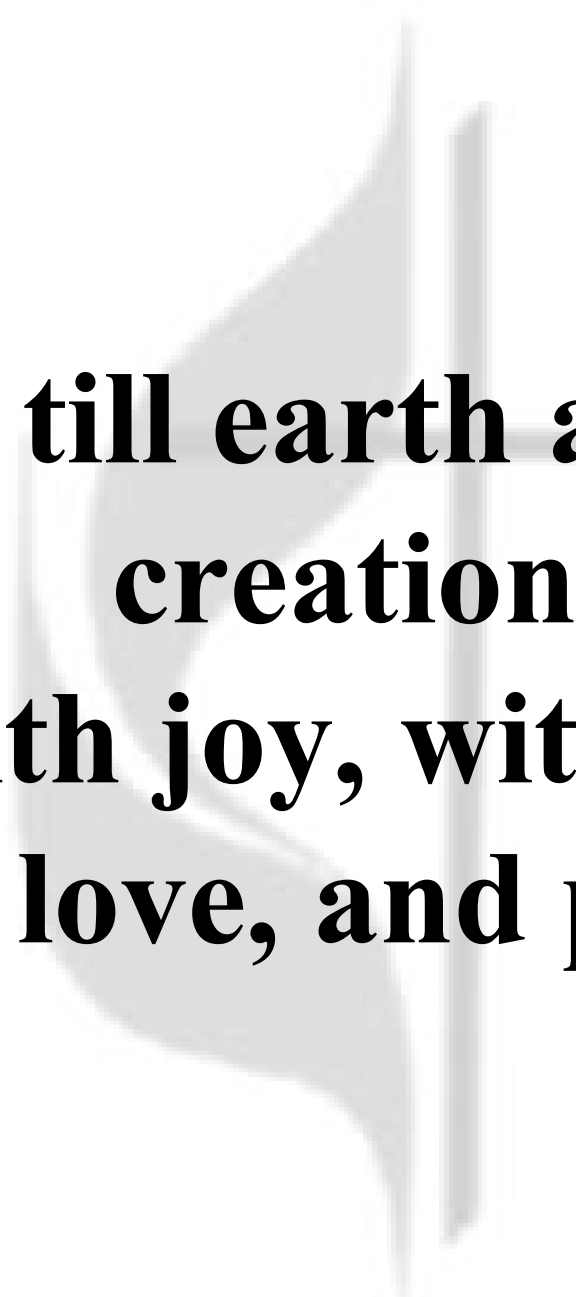
**4. In every insult,
